From Omaha:

1. Take Hwy 75 South toward Bellevue and Plattsmouth.
2. Travel about 5 miles south of Offutt AFB.
3. After you pass the Shell gas station, take the first left. You will see a sign on the right side of the road directing you.
4. Once you turn on Allied road, the road curves left and we are the immediate right.

From Nebraska City:

1. Take Hwy 75 North toward Omaha.
2. Travel about 30 miles until you cross the Platte River.
3. Take a right onto Allied Road. You will see a sign on the other side of the divided highway directing you.
4. Once you turn on Allied road, the road curves left and we are the immediate right.
